The 2015 College Fair and Case Studies Workshop will be held on Sunday, May 3rd.

College Application Case Studies – The Workshop will give you a first hand understanding of how college admissions officers determine who they admit. You will be given three college applications to read in the Workshop. (You may also download the materials from the College and Career Center website or read the materials in the College and Career Center). During the Workshop, the college representative will review the applications and discuss the pros and cons of the sample applications so that you can better present yourself in your own college applications.

The College Fair – will be held in the Jacket Gym and will give you an opportunity to speak with the representatives from 50+ colleges, universities and community colleges. How to Prepare:

- Learn about the colleges you are interested in by checking their websites ahead of time.
- Arrive prepared.
- Research and know the basic GPA and testing requirements for your schools of interest.
- Prepare questions ahead of time.
- Ask questions respectfully, allowing time for other students and families waiting in line. If you have more to ask, return to that college after circulating to other tables.
- Know which schools you would like to visit.
- A list of attending college, junior and community colleges, and universities will be available in the College and Career Center.
- Be organized. Bring pencil and paper rather than writing on the college materials.
- Be respectful and kind.
- Dress in appropriate clothing.
- Do not use cellphones or headphones during the College Fair or Workshop.
- Keep quiet: keep personal comments to yourself as you pass by tables.

Both events are exclusive to BHS Juniors and their families.
